The early Celts used to cut of the heads of there enemies and hang them in the temples of there gods. The served heads were believed to have magical qualities and to be able to speak.



The shields were all different shapes and sizes with Celtic patterns on.

To protect them selves, the Celts wore iron helmets and rich Celts wore fancy gold helmets.



To scare there enemies, in battle the Celts shouted in deep harsh voices and painted there bodies blue to make them look terrifying.

Some Celts covered themselves in chainmail; others went into battle wearing leather tunics.

Sometimes they even went into battle naked and spiked up there hair to scare there enemies.

All Celts carried swords and shields.
