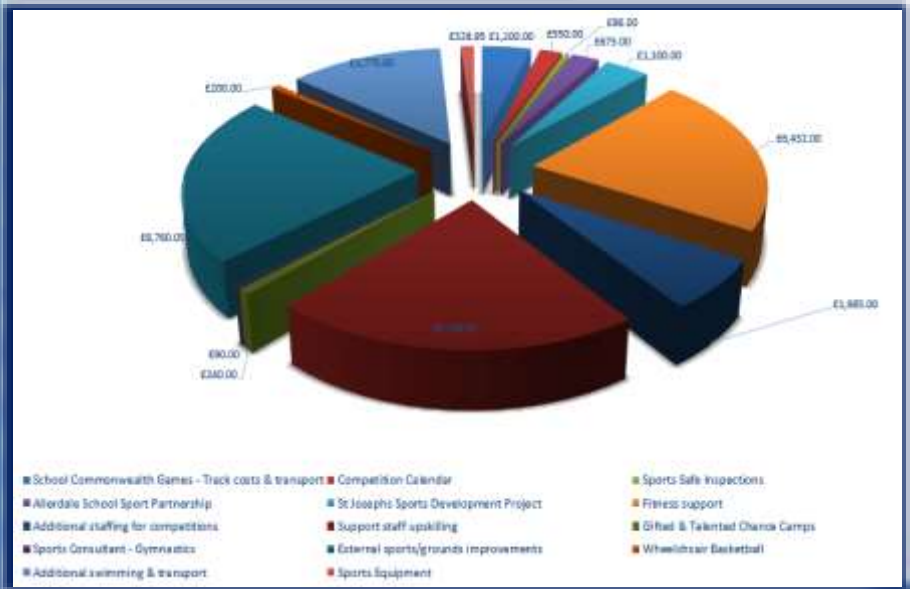

Primary PE and Sport Premium - Key Indicators

There are 5 key indicators that schools should expect to see improvement across:

- The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity - the Chief Medical Officer guidelines recommend that all children and young people aged 3 to 18 engage in at least 60 minutes of physical activity a day, of which 30 minutes should be in school.
- The profile of PE and sport is raised across the school as a tool for whole-school improvement.
- Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport.
- Greater awareness of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils.
- Increased participation in competitive sport.
